*Feline viral rhinotracheitis-Calicivirus-Panleukopenia Vaccine: 3-in-1 that protects from 3 viral diseases. Core vaccine.

** Feline Leukemia Vaccine: Protects from viral leukemia that is spread through saliva. Core vaccine in kittens ≤ 1 year.

^Feline Immunodeficiency Virus: Viral disease that is passed through saliva. There is no vaccine for this.

★Rabies Virus Vaccine: Protects from fatal rabies virus. Core vaccine. Legally required.
