- ★ Rabies Virus Vaccine: Protects from fatal rabies virus. Core vaccine. Legally required.
- ◆Testing is not done until 6-7 months of age minimum, as this is how long it takes the heartworm life cycle to be complete and detectable

^{**}Kennel Cough vaccine: Protects from bacterial Bordetella bronchiseptica. Recommended for boarding, grooming, dog parks, etc.

[^]Leptospirosis Vaccine: Protects from a bacterial Leptospira species spread through wildlife urine. Core vaccine

[¤]Lyme Disease Vaccine: Protects from a bacterial Borrelia burgdorferi spread through tick bites. Recommended for hunting, hiking, etc.
